TRUSTING GOD'S CARE

SPRING IS A TIME TO CELEBRATE GOD'S CREATION! THE SUNSHINE, FLOWERS, AND FRESH AIR REMIND US TO BE THANKFUL FOR EACH DAY. ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILDREN TO TAKE A NATURE WALK, OBSERVE GOD'S BEAUTY, AND PRAISE HIM FOR ALL HE HAS MADE.



NATURE-INSPIRED SPRING ACTIVITIES

HERE ARE SOME FUN NATURE-INSPIRED SPRING ACTIVITIES, OUTDOOR CHALLENGES, AND FUN CRAFTS THAT YOUR CHILDREN WILL ENJOY DOING THIS SPRING! THESE ACTIVITIES ENCOURAGE KIDS TO EXPLORE GOD'S CREATION WHILE LEARNING AND HAVING FUN.

1. SPRING SCAVENGER HUNT

CREATE A LIST OF SPRING-THEMED ITEMS FOR YOUR CHILD TO FIND OUTSIDE, SUCH AS BUDDING FLOWERS, A BIRD'S NEST, A BUTTERFLY, OR A CRAWLING INSECT. YOU CAN ADD BIBLE VERSES ABOUT CREATION, LIKE GENESIS 1:31—"GOD SAW ALL THAT HE HAD MADE, AND IT WAS VERY GOOD."

2. CATERPILLAR TO BUTTERFLY OBSERVATION

RAISE CATERPILLARS AND WATCH THEM TRANSFORM INTO BUTTERFLIES! THIS HANDS-ON SCIENCE ACTIVITY TEACHES PATIENCE AND THE BEAUTY OF GOD'S DESIGN IN NATURE.

3. PLANT A BIBLE GARDEN

PLANT FLOWERS, HERBS, OR VEGETABLES MENTIONED IN THE BIBLE, LIKE MUSTARD SEEDS (MATTHEW 17:20) OR LILIES (LUKE 12:27). THIS IS A GREAT WAY TO CONNECT GARDENING WITH FAITH LESSONS.

4. NATURE ART & LEAF RUBBINGS

COLLECT LEAVES, FLOWERS, OR SMALL TWIGS AND USE THEM TO MAKE RUBBINGS WITH CRAYONS OR CREATE A COLLAGE. TALK ABOUT HOW EACH LEAF AND PETAL IS UNIQUE, JUST LIKE GOD DESIGNED EACH OF US TO BE SPECIAL.

5. BACKYARD BIRDWATCHING

SET UP A BIRD FEEDER AND OBSERVE THE DIFFERENT BIRDS THAT VISIT. KEEP A JOURNAL TO SKETCH OR WRITE ABOUT THEM. DISCUSS MATTHEW 6:26—"LOOK AT THE BIRDS OF THE AIR; THEY DO NOT SOW OR REAP... YET YOUR HEAVENLY FATHER FEEDS THEM."

6. RAINY DAY PUDDLE SCIENCE

AFTER A SPRING RAIN, TAKE A WALK TO OBSERVE PUDDLES. DISCUSS HOW RAIN NOURISHES THE EARTH (ISAIAH 55:10) AND EXPLORE WATER'S PROPERTIES BY JUMPING, MEASURING DEPTH, OR WATCHING RIPPLES.

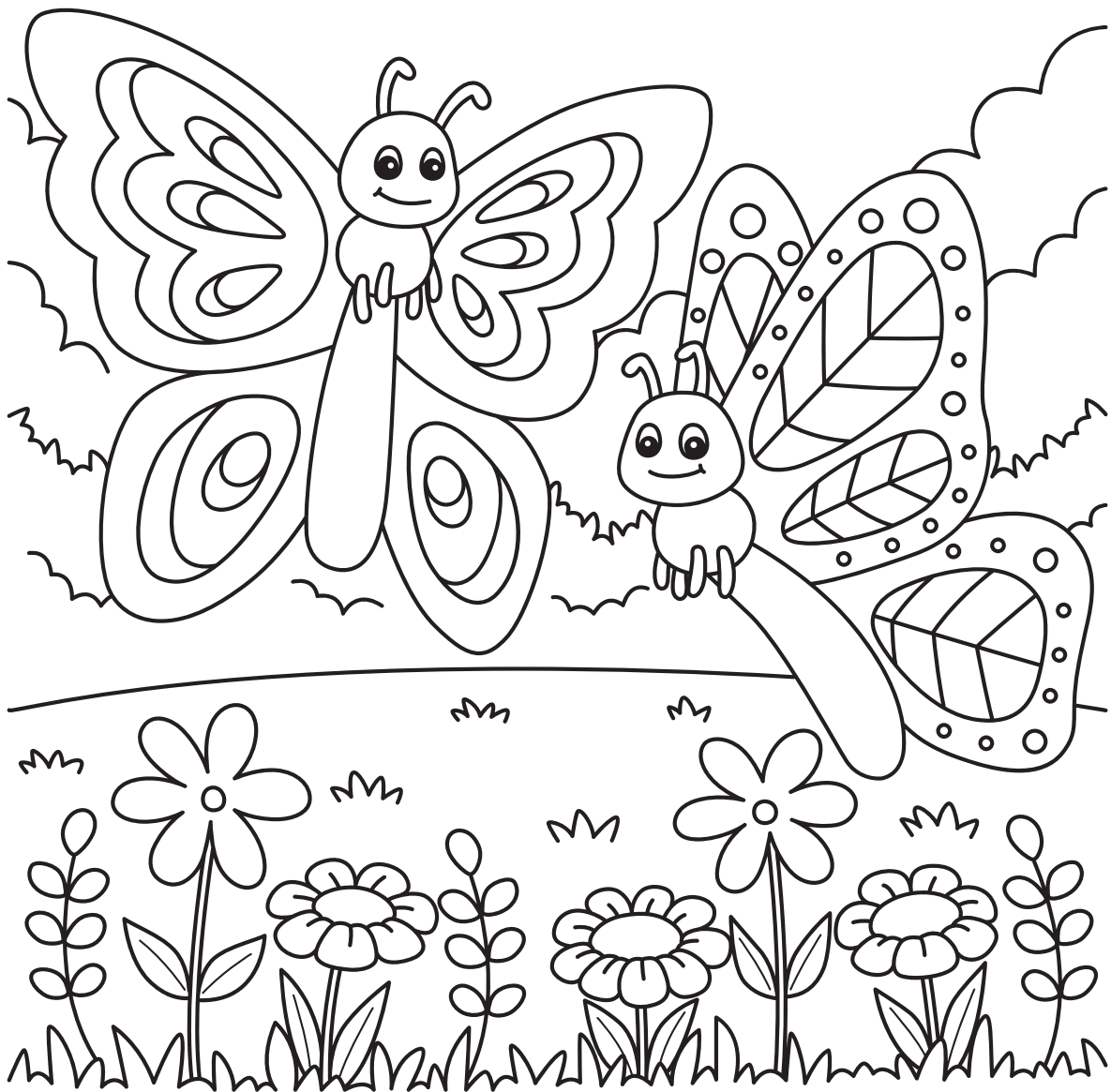
7. BUG SAFARI

GRAB A MAGNIFYING GLASS AND GO ON A BUG HUNT! OBSERVE ANTS, BEETLES, AND BEES, DISCUSSING THEIR ROLES IN GOD'S ECOSYSTEM.

8. OUTDOOR BIBLE STORYTIME

READ BIBLE STORIES OUTSIDE UNDER A TREE OR IN A GARDEN. STORIES LIKE NOAH'S ARK (GENESIS 6-9) OR THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER (MATTHEW 13) CONNECT BEAUTIFULLY WITH NATURE.

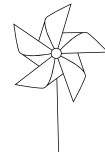
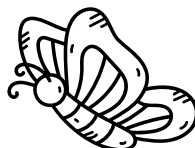
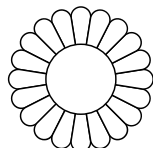
