EMPTY TOMB CRAFT


Create a visual representation of the empty tomb using clay, stones, cardboard, paint, and other craft materials.

Here's what you need:


- a short basin, such as the bottom tray of a plastic planter

- some sticks






HOLY WEEK WOLY WATH





CROSS & TISSUE PAPER CRAFTS



These crosses look beautiful on a window or sliding glass door.


Materials needed:


- tissue paper variety of colors
- wax paper
- white glue
- popsicle stick
- craft knife
- scissors
- cross template (see pages 9 & 10) or draw your own

Directions:

- 1. tear tissue paper into small pieces. Roll out a piece of wax paper that is double the width of the template.
- 2. Spread glue onto half of the wax paper using a popsicle stick.
- 3. Piece by piece add the tissue paper until all the glue is covered.
- 4. Spread glue onto the other half of the wax paper and fold over on top of the tissue.
- 5. Smooth the paper and let dry. I like to put something heavy on top so it dries nice and flat.
- 6. Print out the template and cut out the crosses.
- 7. Run a thin line of glue around the perimeter of the crosses on the back of the paper.
- 8. Turn the paper over and glue it to the wax paper. Let dry.
- 9. Cut out around the crosses and tape to a well-lit window and enjoy!











READ THE STORY OF THE JESUS'S DEATH & RESURRECTION



CHOOSE AGE-APPROPRIATE BOOKS OR BIBLE STORIES ABOUT JESUS' DEATH AND RESURRECTION.

EXPLAINING THE EASTER STORY TO CHILDREN IN TERMS THEY UNDERSTAND REQUIRES CLARIFYING THE TERMS SPECIFIC TO THE MAIN POINTS. THE DEFINITIONS SHOULD BE SHORT AND EASY TO REMEMBER. BEFORE EXPLAINING JESUS' DEATH AND RESURRECTION, MAKE SURE THE KIDS UNDERSTAND THESE BASIC WORDS:

ANGEL: GOD SENDS ANGELS TO DELIVER MESSAGES TO HIS PEOPLE.

CROSS: TWO PIECES OF WOOD MADE INTO A "T" THAT JESUS WAS HUNG ON TO DIE.

DISCIPLE: JESUS' STUDENTS WHO LEARNED FROM HIM AND SHARED THE GOOD NEWS OF EASTER.

SAVIOR: A PERSON WHO PROTECTS AND SAVE PEOPLE FROM DANGER — JESUS IS OUR SAVIOR.

TOMB: WHERE DEAD PEOPLE ARE BURIED.

THE FOCUS WITH PRESCHOOLERS AND YOUNG CHILDREN SHOULD BE ON LOVE AND HOPE. JESUS LOVES US SO MUCH THAT HE DIED ON THE CROSS FOR US. BY DYING AND RISING AGAIN, HE SAVED US FROM OUR SINS. EMPHASIZE THE FACT THAT JESUS' DEATH AND RESURRECTION IS NOT THE END, BUT RATHER, IT'S A NEW BEGINNING FOR EVERYBODY WHO BELIEVES IN GOD AND JESUS CHRIST.


MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL: READ FROM MARK 14 AND JOHN 19-20. IF YOU WANT TO BREAK UP THE READINGS, READ A PORTION OF THE STORY EACH DAY LEADING UP TO EASTER. TAKE TIME TO DISCUSS THE STORY WITH YOUR TEENAGERS AND GIVE THEM FREEDOM TO ASK QUESTIONS.

THIS ACTIVITY SERVES AS A LESSON
ON SERVICE AND HUMILITY, KEY THEMES
IN THE EASTER STORY.



BEGIN BY READING JOHN 13:1-17, WHERE JESUS WASHES THE FEET OF HIS DISCIPLES. AFTERWARD, ENGAGE IN THE FOLLOWING DISCUSSIONS WHILE WASHING EACH OTHER'S FEET:

- JESUS DEMONSTRATED TO HIS DISCIPLES THE IMPORTANCE OF SERVING ONE ANOTHER. HOW DO YOU BELIEVE THEY FELT WHILE HE PERFORMED THIS ACT, KNOWING HE WAS THEIR SAVIOR?
- FOLLOWING THE RESURRECTION, THE DISCIPLES WERE TASKED WITH SPREADING THE GOSPEL TO THE WORLD. HOW DO YOU THINK THEY APPLIED THE LESSON OF SERVICE IN THIS MISSION?
- IN WHAT WAYS CAN YOU EMBODY THE SPIRIT OF SERVICE IN YOUR DAILY LIFE, JUST AS THE DISCIPLES DID?
- ARE THERE ADDITIONAL ACTIONS YOU CAN TAKE IN THE FUTURE TO ASSIST OTHERS?





RESURRECTION EGG HUNT

IF YOU LIKE TO HAVE AN EGG HUNT, HAVE A RESURRECTION EGG HUNT.
INSTEAD OF PLASTIC EGGS FILLED WITH CANDY, FILL THE EGGS WITH
SOMETHING THAT REPRESENTS PART OF THE RESURRECTION STORY. YOU
CAN MAKE YOUR OWN EGGS OR BUY THEM. WHEN ALL THE EGGS HAVE BEEN
FOUND, OPEN THEM. DISCUSS WHAT'S INSIDE AND HOW THAT OBJECT IS
PART OF THE EASTER STORY.

HERE ARE THE OBJECTS YOU WILL NEED IF YOU MAKE YOUR OWN EGGS:

- · 12 PLASTIC EGGS
- · A SMALL STONE TO REPRESENT THE TOMB COVER
- · A PALM BRANCH TO REPRESENT PALM SUNDAY
- · A PIECE OF A CRACKER TO REPRESENT THE LAST SUPPER
- · A FLOWER AS A REMINDER OF THE GARDEN JESUS PRAYED IN
- · SILVER COINS TO REPRESENT JUDAS' BETRAYAL OF JESUS
- · ROPES TO SIGNIFY JESUS' ARREST
- · A "CROWN OF THORNS" TO REPRESENT THE ONE PLACED ON JESUS' HEAD BEFORE THE CRUCIFIXION
- · NAILS TO SYMBOLIZE THE USED FOR THE CRUCIFIXION
- A SMALL PIECE OF SPONGE TO REPRESENT THE VINEGAR OFFERED TO JESUS ON THE CROSS
- · SPICES AND FABRIC TO REPRESENT THE BURIAL OF CHRIST







BAKING IDEAS



MAKE EASTER-THEMED TREATS, SUCH AS RESURRECTION CAKES OR COOKIES, AND DISCUSS THE SYMBOLISM OF THE RESURRECTION WITH THE CHILDREN.

RESURRECTION COOKIES

THESE COOKIES ARE GREAT TO DO WITH THE KIDS. THEY ARE TO BE PREPARED THE NIGHT BEFORE EASTER. THE SPIRITUAL PREPARATION GOES ALONG WITH THE PHYSICAL PREPARATION OF THE COOKIES.

THESE COOKIES USE INGREDIENTS TO EXPLAIN SPECIFIC PARTS OF THE EASTER STORY AND SITE THE COORDINATING CHAPTER AND VERSE FROM THE BIBLE.

AN EXAMPLE IS THE VINEGAR. LET YOUR KIDS POUR THE VINEGAR IN THE MIXING BOWL AND SMELL IT. EXPLAIN THAT JESUS WAS GIVEN VINEGAR TO DRINK WHEN HE WAS THIRSTY ON THE CROSS. THEN, READ BIBLE VERSES JOHN 19:28-30.

SERVINGS: 24

YIELD: 1 1/2 TO 2 1/2 DOZEN

INGREDIENTS

- 1 CUP PECAN HALVES
- 1 TEASPOON DISTILLED WHITE VINEGAR
- 3 EGG WHITES
- 1 PINCH SALT
- 1 CUP WHITE SUGAR

DIRECTIONS



- 1. PREHEAT OVEN TO 300 DEGREES F (150 DEGREES C).
- 2. PLACE PECANS IN A RESEALABLE PLASTIC BAGGIE. CRUSH THE PECANS INTO SMALL BITS. READ JOHN 19:1-3
- 3. PUT 1 TEASPOON VINEGAR INTO A MEDIUM BOWL. READ JOHN 19:28-30
- 4. ADD EGG WHITES TO THE VINEGAR. READ JOHN 10:10-11
- 5. SPRINKLE SALT INTO THE EGG WHITES. READ LUKE 23:27
- 6. SO FAR, THE MIXTURE ISN'T VERY APPETIZING. ADD 1CUP SUGAR. READ PSALM 34:8 AND JOHN 3:16. BEAT WITH MIXER ON HIGH SPEED FOR 12 TO 15 MINUTES UNTIL STIFF PEAKS ARE FORMED. READ ISAIAH 1:18 AND JOHN 3:1-3.
- 7. FOLD IN BROKEN NUTS. DROP BY TEASPOONS ONTO PARCHMENT PAPER LINED BAKING SHEET. READ MATTHEW 27:57-60.
- 8. PLACE COOKIES IN THE OVEN CLOSE THE DOOR AND TURN THE OVEN OFF. READ MATTHEW 27:65-66.
- 9. GO TO BED. READ JOHN 16:20 AND 22.
- 10. IN THE MORNING OPEN THE OVEN AND TAKE OUT THE COOKIES. READ MATTHEW 28:1-9



MORE BAKING IDEAS



EMPTY TOMB RESURRECTION ROLLS

THIS RECIPE FOR ROLLS BEAUTIFULLY ILLUSTRATES HOW JESUS CAME TO EARTH TO ATONE FOR OUR SINS, DESPITE LIVING A SINLESS LIFE. THE NARRATIVE UNFOLDS WITH JESUS' BODY BEING LAID IN A TOMB, BUT THREE DAYS LATER, ANGELS INFORMED HIS FRIENDS THAT HE HAD RISEN, LEAVING THE TOMB EMPTY. JUST LIKE THE PROFOUND LOVE GOD HAS FOR US, THESE ROLLS ARE SWEET AND DELIGHTFUL.

THE EMPTY TOMB ROLLS ARE DESIGNED TO SYMBOLIZE THE BURIAL AND RESURRECTION OF CHRIST. THIS HEARTWARMING LESSON SERVES TO EXPLAIN TO CHILDREN THE SIGNIFICANCE OF OUR EASTER CELEBRATIONS. IN THIS ANALOGY, THE MARSHMALLOW REPRESENTS JESUS' BODY, WHILE THE ROLL DOUGH SIGNIFIES THE TOMB.

INGREDIENTS

- 12 RHODES ROLLS, (OR HOMEMADE DOUGH OR CRESCENT ROLL DOUGH)
- 12 MARSHMALLOWS, (NORMAL SIZED)
- 1/4 CUP GRANULATED SUGAR
- 1 TABLESPOON GROUND CINNAMON
- 1/4 CUP MELTED BUTTER

INSTRUCTIONS

- HEAT THE OVEN TO 350 DEGREES F.
- GREASE A 9×13-INCH BAKING DISH OR A MUFFIN TIN.
- MIX THE SUGAR AND CINNAMON IN A BOWL.
- 1/4 CUP GRANULATED SUGAR,1 TABLESPOON GROUND CINNAMON
- PRESS THE DOUGH OUT INTO A CIRCLE. ROLL A MARSHMALLOW IN THE BUTTER
 AND THEN THE CINNAMON SUGAR AND PLACE ON THE DOUGH.
- 12 RHODES ROLLS,12 MARSHMALLOWS,1/4 CUP MELTED BUTTER
- PINCH THE CIRCLE CLOSED AROUND THE MARSHMALLOW AND ROLL THE DOUGH IN THE BUTTER AND CINNAMON SUGAR.
- PLACE IN THE BAKING DISH.
- REPEAT UNTIL YOU'VE USED ALL THE DOUGH.
- LET REST 15 MINUTES AND THEN BAKE FOR 15 MINUTES OR UNTIL GOLDEN.
- SERVE IMMEDIATELY.

THIS IS A GREAT WAY TO LEARN ABOUT THE RESURRECTION IN A CHURCH SETTING.



ATTENDING A GOOD FRIDAY SERVICE AND AN EASTER SERVICE IS A PERFECT CONVERSATION STARTER TO EXPLAIN THE TRUE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE RESURRECTION EVENTS AND WHAT THEY MEAN TO CHRISTIANS.

ASKING SOME OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS WILL REVEAL ANY LACK OF UNDERSTANDING. HERE ARE SOME EXAMPLES:

- WHY DID JESUS DIE FOR OUR SINS?
- WHAT DID JESUS TELL THE DISCIPLES AT THE LAST SUPPER?
- WHAT HAPPENED ON PALM SUNDAY?
- WHAT HAPPENED IN THE GARDEN WHEN JESUS WENT TO PRAY?
- HOW LONG WAS JESUS IN THE TOMB BEFORE HE ROSE?
- WHAT DOES JESUS' DEATH MEAN FOR US?


