John 8:12 NKJV "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."


Devotion: Jesus brings light where there is fear and confusion.

Scripture Focus:

Family Craft: "Thankful Tree" – cut out paper leaves and write blessings daily to hang on a branch or wall.

Family Night Idea: Harvest Feast – cook a simple fall meal together and share things you're thankful for.

Fun Activity: Pumpkin or apple baking challenge – turn it into a fun family competition!

Shining in the Darkness

Scripture Focus:

Matthew 5:14-16 NKJV "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. No do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before them, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."


Devotion: How small acts of kindness reflect God's light.

Fun Activity: Fall scavenger hunt – find "signs of joy" in nature (e.g., heart-shaped leaf, acorn, colorful tree).


Memory Verse Card: Philippians 4:4




Conversation Starters

- "What blessing are you most thankful for right now?"




